Track learning

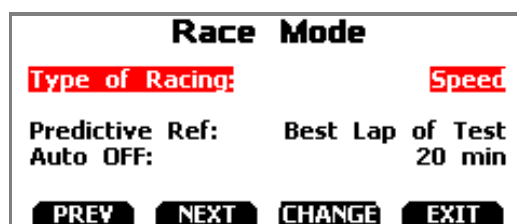
Question:

The track I'm racing in is not available in Race Studio 3 database. What can I do?

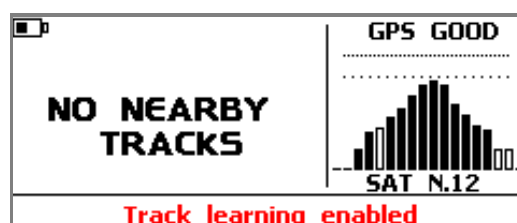
Answer:

If the track is not included into Race Studio 3 database, it is possible to acquire it from Solo 2/Solo 2 DL directly, following the mentioned steps:

- From "MENU" -> "Type of Racing" choose "Speed" (following image), then press "EXIT" to confirm the setting.



- From the main device page, press the "TRACK" button: on the right the GPS signal accuracy graph is displayed, additionally to the number of detected satellites. On the left is shown the list of nearby tracks (within 5kms) if available. If no circuit is listed, the track learning function is automatically enabled (lower image).



- When GPS signal is good, Solo 2/Solo 2 DL starts recording the track points.
- As soon as it detects that it is crossing the same point for the second time, it fixes a temporary start/finish line, to show lap times.
- When the session is over, the resulting track layout appears and it can be stored into Solo 2/Solo 2 DL memory; the start/finish line can be repositioned and a track name can be added with the device keyboard.
- The first time you connect Solo 2/Solo 2 DL to a PC – using Race Studio 3 software – you can download the track and modify its details.
